

# Exhibition of paintings by Hatice Kumbaracı Gürsöz

The works of Hatice Kumbaracı Gürsöz are currently on exhibition in the Emlak Bank Gallery in Ankara, they cover the themes of Memories and Zodiac symbols.

Her work has a very nostalgic feeling to it, and she has managed to give a certain soft timelessness to every painting. Her strong bold lines and masterly use of color subtly addresses the subjects of her work.

Her paintings of still life, beautiful women and people enjoying themselves, give one a tremendous feeling of days gone by.

Hatice Kumbaracı Gürsöz was born in 1945 in Adana. After completing her secondary education she entered the State Academy of Fine Arts, in Istanbul in 1964, where she studied painting and ceramics.

After graduating from the Faculty of Painting in 1969,

she worked as an art teacher in Istanbul, between 1970 and 1973.

She spent more than 10 years in Australia, Pakistan and Germany, where she continued to study the art of painting.

She is a member of the Federal Union of Artists in Germany.

The artist has also participated in various group exhibitions, and has also had many solo exhibitions both in Turkey and abroad.

Many of her works are included in private and official collections and art galleries in Australia, Pakistan, Germany, Finland and Turkey.
